Wishing the new council the very best.



4. <u>Treasurer's report</u>

Renae was thanked by Lorraine prior to sharing the report. Council has managed to continue to bring in revenue and keep financials stable. Online accounting system links in with other platforms and streamlines administration. Handing over the role to Ann Ryan. Audit was completed successfully without question.

5. General Manager report

LDA is considering new ways of operating, but this will be continued by the new council. Membership has increased as acknowledged by Lorraine. Also, acknowledgement of Administrative Officer Bec Rangas' role in following up membership enquiries. Increase in the Twitter, YouTube and other social media membership/following has occurred. The National conference was held in January with over 626 attendees (online and in person due to COVID).

YouTube views have been exceptional and improved the profile of LDA.

Over \$15K (gross) raised through the "High Impact Strategies for Supporting Secondary Students with Learning Difficulties" conference in May.

Over \$20,000 (gross) raised through the "Science of Effective Reading Instruction" seminar in July.

Over \$100K (gross) currently raised through the upcoming "Science of Writing" course. Acknowledged the website committee, especially Renae and Bartek.

The Special General Meeting was held in June, both motions didn't pass. Motions were "That LDA be wound up as an association and a new Company Limited by Guarantee be registered with ASIC" and "That LDA change its name to Effective Teaching Australia". Additional information has since been provided to allow people to continue to consider the options.

Wishing LDA and the new council the best.

Michael thanked LDA for the opportunity as General Manager, this is his last day in the role.

6. Address by incoming president

Robyn Wheldall addressed the meeting as the incoming President of the Council. Stated that the new Council is committed to LDA supporting LD students through evidence based practices and that it has a long and proud history which needs to continue to be developed. Stated that we need to impart knowledge about effective teaching practices as it is what every student needs and LD students need to be in a supported environment.
